

AUGUST 17, 2021 – "I INTEND TO VOTE" at the TOASTMASTERS INTERNATIONAL ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING (ABM) / CLUB PROXY

Three sets of dates are critical to being able to vote at the ABM. Prior to August 17, the club's proxy must be assigned. Between August 17-20, the proxyholder must indicate that they intend to vote. Between August 21–23, the proxyholder needs to attend Electronic Voting Training, and then for 24 hours after the ABM closes on August 26, 2021, the proxyholder votes.

Voting Information for District 36 Clubs at the Annual Business Meeting -Thursday, August 26, 2021 from 8:00 am Eastern Daylight Time (EDT). Your club has important votes to cast to elect International Officers and seven International Directors to the 2021–2022 Board of Directors.

Each club in good standing may cast two (2) votes at the Annual Business meeting. All clubs must designate a proxy to vote. The club can designate a delegate from the club, another active Toastmaster from any club in the world, or the District Director.

IMPORTANT: Your Club Proxy:

The Club President or Club Secretary must assign the club proxy. If the proxy is not assigned, the club's votes cannot be cast. **The club's proxy must be assigned even if you are assigning the proxy to yourself.**

How to Sign Club Proxy

- To assign a club's proxy, go to www.toastmasters.org/ClubCentral, log in, choose the club(s) you
 are assigning proxies for, and click on Club Proxy.
- Once your club's proxy is assigned, please advise the proxyholder to do the following, starting on August 17, 2021.
 - Between August 17 and August 20, log in to the Toastmasters International website and go to the "My Profile" page (or click on the 'Welcome, Name' link). Go to the "View Proxy Information" page. There will be an "I Intend to Vote" button which you need to click to start the Credentials registration process.
 - 2. If you do not complete the Credentials process mentioned above by August 20 at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time (EDT), **you will not be able to vote**.
 - 3. Attend one of the trainings on how to complete and cast your electronic ballot. Training information will be available on the "Annual Business Meeting (ABM)" page of the website during the week of the Toastmasters Virtual Convention.
 - 4. Starting on **August 26, 2021**, after the Annual Business Meeting, log in to the Toastmasters International website and go to the "My Profile" page to access your electronic ballot.

If you wish to have the District Director cast your vote on behalf of your club, I would be proud and honored to do so as many clubs have done. I look forward to seeing you at the Convention if not before.
