
Pathways Training, February 21, 2022


DD LSDES - February 22 - Interpersonal Communication - DISC Profile Workshop




March 10: Finish the Year Strong Plan incentive Deadline

- Complete and submit by March 10th to your Area Director a plan for how the club will achieve Distinguished status
- Include the Current DCP status report of the club at the time of submission
- Receive 10 District Dollars for submitting your club's Finish the Year Strong plan
- If Club achieves Distinguished by April 15th or later, a range of District Dollars will be earned, depending on level of Distinguished status
